The Wall Knights Wrestling Club 2018-2019 Season is scheduled to start practices the first week of November. The club's Online Registration will open on September 1, 2018 and it will remain open until mid-December. The program is open to Wall residents as well as residents of surrounding towns age 5-14. Every wrestler in the program will have the chance to compete against other towns through either our Jersey Shore League matches or through our Developmental program in which wrestlers are paired up according to experience. The cost to register is \$100.00 for our Beginner/Intermediate Program and \$140.00 for our Advanced Program. We practice on Tuesday and Thursday nights in the Wall High School Wrestling Room. The program competes in tournaments throughout the season, has guest clinicians attend practices, provides singlets for our wrestlers, and everyone that joins will get a t-shirt for signing up as well as a trophy at the end of the year awards night. The programs curriculum focuses heavily on the fundamentals of the sport which are taught by a knowledgeable and experienced coaching staff who place an emphasis on teamwork, sportsmanship, and having fun learning wrestling.
