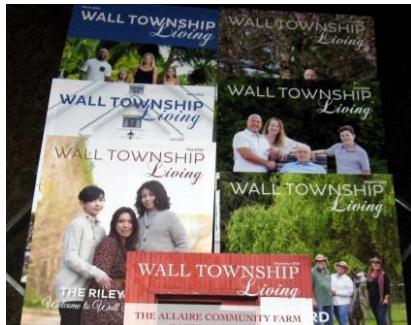


# Environmentally Yours
