Put in the "Recycle" Can

Soon to be picked up twice per month

- Newspaper, office paper
- Junk mail, envelopes, magazines
- Flat corrugated cardboard
- Cereal boxes
- Glass bottles and jars
- Metal food/beverage containers
- Plastic water, soda, milk bottles
- Shampoo, detergent bottles

All loose and mixed in one can - nothing tied (i.e., newspaper/cardboard) and not in plastic trash bags.

Put in the "Trash" Can

As usual, picked up twice per week

- Food, coffee grounds, etc.
- Plastic bags, plastic shopping bags, plastic wrap
- Wax-covered boxes, paper plates
- Pizza boxes
- Diapers
- Plastic utensils, deli containers, etc.
- Styrofoam
- Window glass, ceramics, dishware
- Wire, wire hangers, Christmas lights

Wall Township Single Stream Recycling Program



What is Single Stream Recycling?

“Single stream” is a system that takes the two recycling “streams” – newspaper and commingled containers – and puts them together in one bin. In other words, all the items that are acceptable for recycling can now be put together in one trash can that you place at the curb on your assigned pickup days. These commingled materials will then be hauled to a processing plant specifically designed to mechanically separate the mixed materials so they may be sold (the town gets part of the profit) and re-processed.

When will the Single Stream Recycling Program start?

The exact date has not been determined, but will be sometime early this summer. Watch your mailbox! You will receive notification via mail letting you know when the new program begins.

What else is new about Wall Township’s recycling program?

There are many new items that can be placed in your recycling trash can including flat cardboard, magazines, junk mail and newspapers! Please do not tie up your newspaper or cardboard, simply place them in the same container as all your other recyclables.

Recycling will be picked up at the curb **twice a month**. A recycling schedule with your assigned pickup days will be available soon at www.WallNJ.com/recycle.

Your current household “kitchen” trash and bulk schedule will NOT be affected.

What goes in the recycling can?

Here’s an overview:

- Newspaper, office paper
- Flat corrugated cardboard
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic water, soda, milk bottles
- Junk mail, envelopes, magazines
- Cereal boxes
- Metal food/beverage containers
- Shampoo, detergent bottles

All loose (not in trash bags) and mixed in one can with nothing tied (i.e., newspaper/cardboard).

What goes in the regular trash can?

The following items which are NOT recyclable through single stream:

- Food, coffee grounds, etc.
- Wax-covered boxes, paper plates
- Diapers
- Styrofoam
- Wire, wire hangers, Christmas lights
- Plastic bags, plastic shopping bags, plastic wrap
- Pizza boxes
- Plastic utensils, deli containers, etc.
- Window glass, ceramics, dishware

NOTE: Some items (like plastic shopping bags, which can be recycled at the grocery store) may be recyclable, but are not part of the comingled Single Stream Recycling program. Additionally, many items are recyclable through Wall Township’s Recycling Drop-Off Center. Where is the Recycling Drop-Off Center and when is it open?

The Recycling Center is located on Tiltons Corner Road adjacent to the South Wall Little League fields. The hours of operation are: Monday through Friday from 7:30 am – 3:15 pm and Saturdays from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm.
