

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF WALL, HELD IN THE  
MEETING ROOM, MUNICIPAL COMPLEX  
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 14, 2006**

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The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burne at 7:30 P.M. Present were Mayor Mary L. Burne presiding, Deputy Mayor John W. Tobia, Committeeman Robert D. Peters, Committeeman Edward H. Thomson, Committeeman John P. Devlin, Township Administrator Joseph L. Verruni, Township Attorney Roger J.
