U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup of the Monitor Devices/Intercircuits, Inc. Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is conducting its second five-year review of the Monitor Devices/Intercircuits, Inc. Superfund Site located in Wall Township, Monmouth County, New Jersey. This review will evaluate whether the cleanup plans selected by EPA in the 2005 and Record of Decision (RODs) remain protective of human health and the environment.

The 2005 cleanup plan included in-place bioremediation, which uses microorganisms to break down the contaminants present in the groundwater. This review seeks to confirm that the remedy selected by EPA in the 2005 Record of Decision (ROD), is protective of human health and the environment.

A summary of the five-year review activities and an evaluation of the long-term protectiveness of the cleanup plans will be included in the upcoming five-year review report. **The report is expected to be completed by June 2022.**

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

EPA inspects Superfund sites every five years to ensure that cleanups conducted remain fully protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspecting the site and cleanup technologies;
- Reviewing monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records; and,
- Determining if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.
